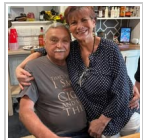

God is with you in this difficult time but Anthony lives with you Norma in your heart forever. Thank you for sharing this awesome man with me/familia. RIP Anthony 💔

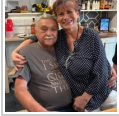

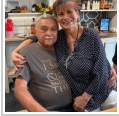
