



Corelia "Cora" Gonzales

January 26, 1927 - December 27, 2022

Alamosa resident Corelia (Cora) Gonzales, passed away on December 27, 2022 at the Evergreen Nursing Home in Alamosa with her daughter and son-in-law by her side. Cora was born on January 26, 1927 in Amalia, New Mexico the daughter of Lugardita and Erineo Vallejos and was raised by her sister Lucinda Lucero and brother-in-law Ricardo Lucero. Cora was united in marriage to Jose (Joe) Agapito Gonzales on April 25, 1947 in Costilla, New Mexico. Joe preceded her in death on September 19, 2019.

Shortly after marriage, Cora and Joe moved to Colorado where they secured jobs working with the Fujimoto family at the Carmel Ranch. Cora worked at the local schoolhouse. She and Joe harvested crops and worked at the Helm's Potato Warehouse. In 1957, Joe and Cora made their home in Alamosa. Cora, "Corita as Fay called her", was a cook at the Mexico Cafe working for Faye Jewett more commonly known as "Chata". Cora continued working in the restaurant business at the Cow Camp, and at the Bel Air Café. In 1980, Cora retired from the Housekeeping Department at the San Luis Valley Regional Medical Center.

Cora, was a faithful servant and devout member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. She was a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother, and great grandmother. She was a fantastic cook and enjoyed gardening, canning food, fishing, camping, embroidering, listening to Spanish music, and spending time

with her loving family.

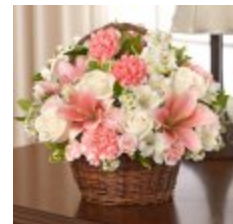
