Frank J. Alonzo, 94, passed away on Saturday, March 25, 2023, in La Jara, Colo. Frank was born on Nov. 9, 1928, in Alamosa, Colo., the son of Francisco and Dometilla Alonzo. He was a wonderful father, grandfather, brother, uncle, cousin and friend to many.

Grandpa Frank's faith was strong; he loved God, enjoyed church, fishing, camping, ranching, playing solitaire and watching sports. Most of all, he enjoyed spending time with his family and friends. He was always there when needed.

On Jan. 7, 1945, at the young age of 17, Frank married the love of his life, Mabel, in Taos, N.M. They later moved to Denver and welcomed their two children, Robert and Nancy. In his early years, Mr. Alonzo worked as a route delivery supervisor for Canada Dry Bottling Company.

After years of living in the city, the Alonzos moved back to Alamosa to raise their family. He began working at Big O Tire, starting as a janitor but quickly learning how to do alignments, suspensions and brakes. Frank later started his own business in the 80s— Frank's Front End & Tire Service.

It was hard to keep a good man down; after retirement he worked for several years as a greeter at Wal-Mart.

After 65 years of marriage, Mabel passed in 2008. The love the Alonzos built was a great example for their family to live by.

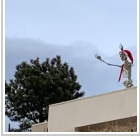
