Jessie Reese Garcia was born on October 8, 1968, at 0330 in San Miguel, NM, as the eighth child of Alfredo and Lucy Garcia. He passed away unexpectedly at his residence on September 29, 2025. Jessie spent his formative years in both San Miguel, NM, and Antonito, CO. He pursued studies in automotive mechanics in Utah through Job Corps and began his career specializing in mechanics. Jessie held a position as a Heavy Equipment Operator with Southway Construction LLC.
