He was the recipient of several distinguished awards (National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with 5 Bronze Service Stars, Vietnam Campaign w/60 Device, Armed Force Expeditionary Medal, Vietnam Cross of Gallantry w/Palm 3 Overseas Service Bars, an Aircraft Crewman Badge, a Purple Heart and many more). On August 11, 1977 Bob received an honorable discharge and went on to live out the rest of his life cherishing moments with his loved ones.

He belonged to the American Legion Post 113 of Alamosa, Dickey Springer Building Committee and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 899. He was the post Commander of the American Legion Post 113 and he had the honors of being elected the Grand Marshal.

While we mourn the loss of Bob, we also celebrate the incredible person he was and the legacy he leaves behind. He will be missed by the multitude of lives he touched.
