Salomon G Garcia of Centennial, Colorado died on July 17, 2025 following a long illness. Salomon was born in Del Norte, CO on November 11, 1946. He graduated from Creighton University and Creighton Medical School in Omaha, Nebraska. His specialty was Gastroenterology and he had a passion for his chosen field.
